**CHILDCAREGROUP ANNOUNCES LEADERSHIP TEAM FOR ITS
'GREAT ADVENTURE HUNT' FUNDRAISER**

The Great Adventure Hunt is not only one of the most unique fundraising events in Dallas, but more importantly, it raises critical funds necessary for ChildCareGroup to provide safe, quality, early care and education programs for the youngest and neediest citizens in Dallas County. In addition, CCG serves 595 children through Head Start and Early Head Start programs at its seven child development centers. 2011 marks the 110th anniversary of ChildCareGroup.
