

Explore worlds of fun with your child at the library

The library offers children a whole world of knowledge, fun and imagination. Children are never too young to go to the library.

Here's how to make library learning a regular part of your child's life:

- **Practice before you go.** See if your child can use a soft library voice and handle books with care.
- **Find good times to visit**—times when you won't be rushed.
- **Give your child her own library bag** for carrying books.
- **Befriend the librarian.** Introduce your child. Ask where to find books, magazines, videos and tapes of stories and songs that will appeal to your child. Ask for her recommendations.
